Maths

20 $2^x = \frac{2^y}{\sqrt{2}}$ $2^x = (\sqrt{2})^y$

Given that $x + y = 8$
work out the value of n .

$$2^x = \frac{2^n}{2^{\frac{1}{3}}} \quad 2^y = (2^{\frac{1}{2}})^5$$

$$2^x = 2^{n - \frac{1}{3}} \quad 2^y = 2^{\frac{5}{2}}$$

$$n - \frac{1}{3} + \frac{5}{2} = \frac{8}{1}$$

$$n = \frac{11}{2} - \frac{1}{3} = \frac{35}{6} = 5\frac{5}{6}$$

History

2 (a) Study Sources A and B in the Sources Booklet.

How useful are Sources A and B for an enquiry into conditions in lodging houses in the Whitechapel area?

Explain your answer, using Sources A and B and your knowledge of the historical context.

Source A is useful for an enquiry into conditions in lodging houses as they describe the inhabitable and concerning aspects of the lodging houses. For example, the accounts of overcrowding in places such as the kitchen and bedrooms, suggest how lodging houses were not safe and unsanitary for people of that time. Further, the descriptions of the lodging houses can be further interpreted by "Two or three times as many people as the appalling filth", suggesting how people with disabilities or any other conditions would have a difficult time living in such conditions.
